November 27, 2012

1. Meeting called to order at 7:07 PM.
2. Minutes of the 9/25/12 meeting were reviewed. Carol made a motion to accept and Bill seconded. All were in favor.
3. Environmental Board: The Environmental Board is working on trying to get people to make an effort to increase what they recycle and decrease the amount of solid waste they produce. Monetary issues may motivate an increase in recycling. Carol mentioned that at Feeney's on the Rondout were people bringing many recyclables and getting money. Some of the things they were collecting money for include car batteries, crushed and bundled cans, cardboard and large metal objects.
4. Patty Brooks presented two actions the Planning Board asked us to review. One is a lot line adjustment PB2012-23 DeCicco/Scenic Hudson and a minor subdivision PB 2012-24 Gordon/Scenic Hudson. This is part of a conservation easement and Scenic Hudson's plan for open space. The Waterfront Advisory Board did not find any inconsistencies with the LWRP * regarding either of these actions.
5. Carol and Joe were talking about the geese at the beach in Freer Park. John C said that the DEC said they can shoot them. Carol said that there will be many people at Riverview upset if they look out and see people shooting geese. They will be likely to complain as a group. Catherine said that Marion had ideas of ways to deter the geese and we will ask her at a future meeting.
