OLD BUSINESS:

Big 3:

Water Treatment Plant: Upgrade has been completed. GC to return for minor details.

Water Tank: Arold to commence work when available.

Distribution System: Nothing new to report.

Task List:

Control panel upgrade – PLC Upgrade – Spoke with Avante Control Systems who conducts system integrations. The PLC 5 will be unsupported in the near future. The new PLC needed to go out for bid and specifications were prepared. The new PLC replacement would be seamless and operate efficiently for years.

Engineering Planning Grant (EPG) – Waiting on official results.

Annual Water Quality Report – Completed May 2024 and posted on the Town’s Bulletin Boards. The report will be placed on the water bills when mailed in July.

Lead Service Line Inventory - Had virtual meeting with Computer Support Technician Mike Rice, Mike Dauner and Supervisor Freer to determine how to create a questionnaire on the Town’s

website to obtain public information. Dan Valentine of Tighe & Bond had created a “live” form to provide Mike Rice to install and the information would be provided on the water bills as well as a mailer to customers.

Foreman Report:

Forman Dauner had prepared and provided his report for May 2024 (annexed hereto). Paving had commenced in coordination with the Highway Department. Preparing extensively for paving Salem Street.

UCHD Report – Nothing new to report.

NEW BUSINESS:

2024 Sewer Flow Stats – January 2024 through May 2024 flow report had been conducted.

Lakeshore Villas – Met on May 22, 2024. They had been requested to conduct an I & I study. They had also been requested to provide a flow report and a flow meter had been purchased and 1 month of data had been collected. The Town must be assured that the 10.4% discharges are not negatively impacted.

Training and Schools – Mike Miller and Shawne DeGroat successfully passed the Grade D Water Operators Course.

Water & Sewer Bills – Mailing to take place the 1st week of July, 2024.

Vouchers- Distributed to Members for review. Upon Motion of Member Post, seconded by Member Rentfrow, the vouchers were approved for submission for payment.
